Eligibility : Players should be born on or after **1st January 2002**.

Entry Registration : Name with AOCAID must be sent to the concerned person through or **WhatsApp** 94370-65522 before **05:00 P.M.** on **17th May 2019**. New players will have to enroll their names before 09:00 P.M. on 10 May through E-mail with the attachment of Date of Birth Certificate & Photo. **Late fee ₹100/-** will be charged to the participant requesting for spot entry.

AOCA Players Registration : All participants in the championship should be registered with All Odisha Chess Association for the year 2019 – 2020. The amount should be paid with the duly filled and signed AOCA Players Registration form, one passport size photograph & Xerox copy of Birth Certificate.

Date of Birth Certificate & Birth Registration : Participants whose date of birth is not registered within one year will be allowed to participate in the state tournaments but his/her name will not be forwarded for National Championship until unless he/she clears the medical test by AICF.

System of Play & Session : The championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. The rate of play will be 60 minute with an increment of 30 second per move from move number one (only in FIDE approved clock). (Players are requested to bring their own chess clock)

Tie Break : The following tie-break will be followed.

1. Direct encounter
2. Buchholz
3. Buchholz Cut 1
4. Sonneborn Berger
5. The greater number of wins

Protests : Protests, if any, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ₹ 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Prize Distribution Function : Prize distribution function is compulsory for all players. The participants not attending the prize distribution function will not get the prize as well as certificate.

State Qualifiers : The top two (2) players from Open & Girls category will be selected to represent Odisha State in the forthcoming National (U-17) Boys/Girls Championship 2019 from 29th June to 07th July at Kochi, Kerala.

Accommodation : Free dormitory accommodation will be available for out stationed players subject to intimate before 05:00 P.M. on 17th May 2019.
