If players strength will be 10 or below, only top 5 prizes will be given & No age group prizes will be given.

COVID Protocol: All participants are required to maintain social distancing and hand sanitization at the tournament hall. Wearing of mask is mandatory at all times when you are inside tournament hall. By enrolling for the events, the players have to abide by all the terms and conditions of the championship for participation.

Eligibility : Players should be born on or after **1st January 2008**.

Entry Registration : Name with AOCA ID must be sent to the concerned person through **WhatsApp** @ **7008808211, 7008352104** before **08:00 P.M.** on **22nd April 2022**. New players will have to enroll their names before 09:00 A.M. on 23rd April 2022. Entry will be closed at 08.00 P.M. on 22nd April 2022. Strictly, no entry will be entertained after that, failing which a player may not pair for the 1st Round. Decision of Chief Arbiter will be final and binding to all.

Date of Birth Certificate & Birth Registration : It is compulsory to bring a copy of date of Birth for all participants. However, whose date of birth is not registered within one year will be allowed to participate in the state tournaments but his/her name will not be forwarded for National Championship. Player/state can appeal to AICF in this regard as per the notification published at <https://aicf.in/public-notice-dob-issue/> with undertaking and supporting documents.

System of Play & Session : The championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. The rate of play will be decided in Players meeting. (Players are requested to bring their own chess clock).

AICF Registration : AICF registration of Rs 250/-for the Year 2022-23 is compulsory for all the players. The player registrations will be accepted only through online on www.aicf.in. Players registration should be done well before the start of event (Tournament). For renewing AICF registration of existing players, please click <http://aicf.in/players/>. For fresh AICF registration please click <http://aicf.in/online-playersregistration/>. For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address (unique) not used by any other person/player for AICF, ready before the registration process. Note: Only Passport size (less than 1MB)photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.

Tie Break : The following tie-break will be followed.

(a) Buchholz Cut 1 (b) Buchholz (c) Sonneborn-Berger (d) Direct Encounter (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included) (f) Greater no. of wins by Black.

Protests : Protests, if any, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of ` 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Prize Distribution Function : Prize distribution function is compulsory for all players. The participants not attending the prize distribution function will not get the prize as well as certificate.

State Qualifiers : The top four (2) players from Open & Girls category will be selected to represent Odisha State in the forthcoming MPL 34th National (U-14) OPEN & GIRLS Chess Championships 2022 from 9th – 14th May 2022 at Ahmedabad, Gujarat.

Accommodation : Free dormitory accommodation will be provided to all the players,subject to prior intimation on or before 21st April'2022.

Certificate: All participants will get State Level Certificate.

Special Attraction: Railway 3AC To & Fro ticket (BBSR - Ahmadabad and back) to top 2 selected Boys and Girls.
