Eligibility: Only player residing in the state of Odisha are eligible to participate in the Championship, subject to AICF registration. New player must bring one passport size photo and one copy of Date of Birth Certificate (below 25 year).

(The Organiser will have the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.)

System of Play: The Championship will be played as per FIDE laws of Chess with 9 Rounds.

Time Control: 90 minutes with 30 seconds increment from move no.1 for the entire game.

Tie Break: The following tie-breaks will be applied.

1. Buchholz Cut-1
2. Buchholz
3. Sonneborn-Berger
4. Direct encounter
5. The greater number of wins including forfeits.
6. Number of wins with Black pieces.

However, the cash prizes will not be shared.

Default Time: The default time will be 30 minutes.

Cross Pairing: Can be done/is allowed, to avoid the walk-over point in the 1st round.

Mobile Phones / Wrist Watches / any electronic devices for communication are strictly not allowed inside the tournament hall during the game. Players may keep it in a separate bag with a switch-off mode. If the same is found during the game, participants are liable to lose the game or his/her game will be treated as lost (Article 11.3.2).

Withdrawal: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event subject to notification of the Chief Arbiter, or else he/she will be considered as withdrawn/treated as withdrawn from the tournament.

Analysis of Game: Analysis in the tournament hall during the game is strictly not allowed.

Protest: Protest if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing before the Appeals Committee with a protest fee ₹1,000/- within 15 minutes of occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if appeal is upheld.

Appeal Committee: Before the commencement of the tournament, a three member appeals committee shall be formed by the organisers. All members and the reserves shall be from the different districts/units. No members of the committee can vote on the dispute in which a player from his own district is involved. In such case(s) reserve member(s) shall take his/her place in the committee. The decision of the appeals committee is FINAL and BINDING.

Disqualification: No player shall leave the venue before the Prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

State Qualifiers(Open): Top four(4) players will qualify for the upcoming "National Chess Championship 2023" to be held at **Nasik**, Maharashtra from **15th to 27th Aug 2023**.
