












BHUBANESWAR: A TEMPLE CITY

Rules / Regulations / Information:



- System of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with 10 rounds in Category 'A' & 'B' and 9 Rounds in Category 'C'. The latest FIDE rules in force shall apply.
- For Indian players, AICF registration for the financial year (01/04/2023 to 31/03/2024) is mandatory.
 - To renew: https://prs.aicf.in/player
 - To register: https://prs.aicf.in/new-register
- For foreign players a valid FIDE ID is mandatory.
- An Appeals Committee will be formed before the start of the Tournament, comprising of 5 members. Appeals Committee's decision will be final and binding on all the players concerned.
- Tie-break: In case of a tie, the latest FIDE Rules shall come into effect as per AICF guidelines. However, the cash prizes will not be shared. One player will be given one (higher) prize (in the played Category).
- <u>Protest</u> if any, against the decision of the Arbiter, Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing
 with protest a fee of ₹ 1,000/- within 15 minutes after the completion of the game to the
 committee. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- Withdrawals: After informing the Chief Arbiter in writing, a player may withdraw at any event stage.
- FIDE Fair Play Regulations will be in force, and players must respect the rules.

 Players are not allowed to carry mobile phones, wristwatches (of any type) and other electronic devices to the playing area, during the Tournament.
- There will be tax deductions of foreign players' prize money as per the Govt. guidelines.

 Indian Income Tax Act and Rules will be applicable.
- Prize money will be transferred online mode and in INR (Indian National Rupee) only.
 Participation in this tournament will be accepted as the player's consent to take photos, videos in this event for publishing and promotions.
- **E-Certificate** will be awarded to all the participants.
- Venue/Transport: Players are requested to report directly at the venue. Airport is approximately 5.73 kms from the venue. The Railway Station approximately 3.73 kms from the venue. MO BUS nos.(23, 30) are available from Railway Station. However, the organizers will make arrangements to drop the players after the completion of the event.
- Our Helpdesk will be at the Airport and railway station for players & accompanying persons.


